On opening day -from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.- patrons can sample free authentic gelato made fresh in-house at the Country Club with machines imported from Italy.

Be among the first to preview the Italian-inspired menu of Panini, oven baked pizza, pressed sandwiches and wraps, soups, salads, pastries and specialty coffees.

The operator of the Country Club, Coral Grand LLC, which has made a substantial investment in the renovation and commercial success of this historic facility, plans on opening a restaurant late this year and banquet facilities next year.
